

Beyond the August 2014 Numbers...

Additional Data after Release of Indiana's Monthly Employment Report

- Over the past year, Indiana's unemployment rate declined 1.7%, which is the 5th largest decrease in the nation. Indiana's decline of 5.0% since July of 2009, the low point of employment in the state, ranks 3rd in the U.S.
- Indiana's labor force has grown by more than 51,000 over the past year (+51,096), at a rate that is over 5 times the national rate of growth (1.6% vs 0.3%).
- Total Private Sector employment in the Hoosier State is now at 2,571,400, which is the highest since December of 2000. Indiana is now only 41,200 private sector jobs below its peak of employment, which occurred in March of 2000.
- Indiana still leads the nation in Manufacturing job growth over the past year (+20,100), and is 2nd in the nation in rate of growth over the past year (+4.1%).
- The Hoosier State has added the 2nd most Manufacturing jobs (+84,100) in the U.S. since July 2009, at a rate that also ranks 2nd in the nation (+19.7%).
- Indiana continues to have the highest concentration of private sector Manufacturing jobs in the U.S.
- Indiana's private sector job growth over the past year (+56,400) ranks 9th in the nation.
- Since July 2009, Indiana has added 244,000 Private sector jobs, which ranks 10th in the nation, at a rate of 10.5%, which ranks 8th in the nation.
- The Hoosier State ranks 9th in the nation over the past year in Construction job growth (+7,600), at a rate that is also 9th in the U.S. (+6.3%)
- Since July 2009 Indiana has added 12,700 Construction jobs, which ranks 8th in the nation, at a rate of 10.9%, which is 7th in the U.S.
