In compliance with the requirements of the Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN Act"), 29 U.S.C. § 2102, U.S. Foodservice, Inc., hereby notifies you of the pending closure of its entire North Star Foodservice – Bloomington facility located at 311 N. Curry Pike, Bloomington, IN 47404.

The Company expects this closure to permanently eliminate all positions at this facility on or around October 3, 2009. All affected employees have been notified. The affected employees are not represented by a union and bumping rights do not exist with respect to this reduction-in-force.
