Re: *WARN Act Notice of Plant Closing at the Greensburg, Indiana Facility of Printpack, Inc. -- UPDATE*

Dear Mr. Miller, Mayor Herbert, and President Buening:

As we advised you by letter dated November 17, 2010, and again on February 4, 2011, Printpack, Inc. began the process of permanently closing its entire Greensburg, Indiana plant located at 1505 West Main Street, Greensburg, IN 47240 on January 20, 2011.

In accordance with the terms of the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification ("WARN") Act, Printpack, Inc. also timely notified its Greensburg employees of the plant's permanent closing. Since that initial notice, the expected dates of discharge for a small subset of these employees have been extended. Printpack has timely notified the affected employees of this extension.

The main points communicated to you previously have remained unchanged. The closure is of the entire facility and is still expected to be permanent. The total number of affected employees is now approximately 50.

Additional information required by the WARN Act is maintained by Printpack and available on request. As Printpack continues to work through this fluid process, you may contact me for further information at the number listed above.
