

**Re: Supplemental Notice of Layoff**

Dear Ms. Long:

As you are aware by virtue of the September 23, 2015 notice previously sent to your attention, Carter Fuel Systems has decided to reduce its operations at its facility in Logansport, Indiana located at 101 Industrial Blvd. In that prior notice, Carter Fuel Systems advised you that it expected to eliminate 111 positions at that facility commencing between November 22, 2015 and December 6, 2015 and that the affected employees have bumping rights under the operative collective bargaining agreement. As a result of those bumping rights being applied, the prior listing of the job titles of positions affected and the number of affected employees in each position is no longer accurate. Attached hereto is an updated list of the job titles of positions affected and the number of affected employees in each position after bumping rights were determined. Also, the number of affected employees has been reduced to 110 due to a retirement that becomes effective October 5<sup>th</sup>. The chief elected officer for the United Steelworkers, Local #4863 is still Daniel J. Arnett, President, 101 Industrial Blvd., Logansport, Indiana 46947.
