

Re: Revised Notice of Facility Closing Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 ("WARN")


Dear DWD Representative:

On April 14, 2014, we provided you with notice under the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act of 1988 ("WARN") of our intention to permanently close the Chesapeake Pharmaceuticals and Healthcare Packaging facility located at 15220 Foundation Avenue, Evansville, IN 47725 on June 14, 2014. This notice is intended to update that earlier notice.

Although the Company still intends to permanently close its Evansville facility, in order to ensure a smooth transition of work to other facilities and to minimize the impact of this decision on our customers, it now appears that certain employees will be retained longer than we originally had planned. Based on our present business circumstances, we expect to close the plant between October 17, 2014 and October 31, 2014. In total, 63 employees will be affected by the plant closure. Based on the impending closing, employees have been allowed to voluntarily separate from employment with post-separation benefits if they meet certain conditions. The first such separations occurred on May 9, 2014. As of the date of this letter, 29 of the facility's employees have terminated their employment. The remaining employees will be allowed to voluntarily separate or will be released as work is wound down between now and October 31, 2014. A list of the job titles affected by this action and the number of affected employees in each job is maintained at the Evansville facility.

As we previously informed you, certain of the affected employees are represented by Local 571-M of District Council 3 Graphic Communications Conference/International Brotherhood of Teamsters. We have met with the Union to discuss the closing and will continue to coordinate our activities going forward as to those employees it represents. The names and addresses of the chief elected Union officials appear at the end of this Notice. We have also provided the affected non-union employees at the facility with updated notices of their new expected separation dates. Bargaining unit employees who may be involuntarily released between now and the closing will

have bumping rights as provided in the applicable collective bargaining agreement or as otherwise agreed to with the Union. Non-union employees have no bumping rights. Upon the plant closing, no employees will have bumping rights.
