Responsibilities of the taskforce going forward:

- Respond to evolving WIOA initiatives, updates, and regulations by offering strategic guidance on policies and technical assistance to be established by DWD;
- Oversee any requested or required modifications of the State plan as required by the United States Department of Education and/or Department of Labor;
- Review recommendations for criteria and policy regarding the WIOA requirement that the Local Board must select the one-stop operator through a competitive process at least once every 4 years; and
- Provide guidance on the Eligible Training Provider List alignment of processes and policy with WIOA, including making decisions on appeals.


WIOA Convening “One Team, One Vision, One Conversation”
