Enclosed with this letter is a tariff revision for AT&T Indiana's I.U.R.C. Tariff No. 20 which sets forth exceptions to the Ameritech Operating Companies (Ameritech) Tariff F.C.C. No. 2.

Specifically, new term plans longer than 36 months will no longer be available for certain services and existing term plans will no longer be renewed or extended for terms greater than 36 months. Services impacted by this change include: Base Rate (DS0), DS1, DS3, and Direct Analog Service.

This filing is being made under 170 IAC 1-6 Thirty-Day Administrative Filing Procedures and Guidelines. An effective date of November 20, 2013 is requested.
