Dear Secretary:

Pursuant to 170 IAC 1-6 and as approved in Cause No. 44511, I&M submits this thirty-day filing requesting approval of an initial fixed block Monthly Rate for I&M's Green Power Rider (GPR). In support of this thirty-day filing, I&M represents that on February 4, 2015 in Cause No. 44511, the Commission approved I&M's GPR. I&M's GPR provides customers the opportunity to support the development of solar power by voluntarily subscribing each month to a specific number of 50 kWh blocks of Solar Renewable Energy Certificates (SRECs). In addition, in Cause No. 44511, the Commission approved I&M's request to establish the GPR fixed block Monthly Rate using the most appropriate vintage of Pennsylvania Solar REC (PA SREC), as published by SNLEnergy in its Power Daily Newsletter RECs Index.

As provided in Attachment A, the fixed block Monthly Rate is based on the 2016 Vintage 52-week average of the Pennsylvania Solar REC for the period ending July 10, 2015. One Solar REC represents 1,000 kWh. Therefore, as shown below, the resultant 52-week average Solar REC price (\$44.17) is divided by 20 to derive the 50 kWh block rate.

**50 kWh Block Monthly Rate = 52-Week Average SREC Price (\$44.17) / 20 = \$2.21**

I&M requests approval of the initial 50 kWh block Monthly Rate, derived above, with an effective date of October 1, 2015 as shown on the attached GPR tariff sheet. The requested approval of I&M's GPR block rate will establish the GPR block rate to be in effect through 2016. Putting the block rate into effect as of October 1, 2015 will allow I&M to begin marketing the GPR to those I&M customers that are interested in supporting I&M's Clean Energy Solar Pilot Project and enable them to demonstrate their individual support for solar energy. In accordance with the Commission Order in Cause No. 44511, all revenues received under the GPR will be used to offset the cost of the Solar Power Rider (SPR). Also, in accordance with the Order, I&M will retire all SRECs purchased by its customers.

In support of this 30-Day filing, I&M is submitting the following information:



**GREEN POWER RIDER (GPR)**

Availability of Service.

Available on a voluntary basis to customers who are in good standing and desire to purchase renewable energy credits from the Company's owned solar resources. Participation under this Rider shall be limited by the availability of Solar Renewable Energy Certificates (SRECs). If the annual total of all kWh under this Rider equals or exceeds 90% of the Company's Indiana retail jurisdictional share of projected SRECs to be produced by the Clean Energy Solar Pilot Project, the Company shall suspend the availability of this Rider to new participants.

Conditions of Service.

Customers who wish to additionally support the development of electricity generated by I&M's solar resources may voluntarily subscribe to purchase each month a specific number of fixed SREC blocks in increments of 50 kWh per block. The Company will retire the SRECs associated with the energy purchased by participating customers on an annual basis upon receipt of payment from the customer. The proceeds of this rider will be used toward offsetting the cost of the Solar Power Rider (SPR) for all customers.

Monthly Rate.

In addition to the monthly charges determined according to the Company's rate schedule under which the customer takes service, the customer shall participate in the Green Power Rider by subscribing to a specific number of fixed blocks at a rate of:

\$2.21 for each 50 kWh block subscribed.

The Company will update the fixed block rate on an annual basis, based on the most appropriate vintage of Pennsylvania Solar REC, as published by SNLEnergy in its Power Daily Newsletter RECs Index. If the SREC product index is no longer available or the state of Indiana adopts a Renewable Portfolio Standard that includes solar, the Company will select a replacement SREC product as the basis for establishing the monthly rate.

Terms of Service.

This is a voluntary program. Customers eligible for this Rider may participate by applying to the Company for service under this Rider. Once approved for service under this Rider, service will begin within a minimum of fifteen (15) days of the customer's regular scheduled meter reading date. Customers may terminate service under this Rider by notifying the Company with at least thirty (30) days notice prior to the customer's regular scheduled meter reading date.

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

Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), an Indiana corporation, gives notice that on or before July 31, 2015, it will submit for approval under the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission's thirty-day filing process a request to approve a monthly fixed block rate per 50 kWh for I&M's Green Power Rider to be effective October 1, 2015. The referenced filing will consist of Indiana Michigan Power Company's calculation of a fixed block monthly rate per 50 kWh for I&M's Green Power Rider based upon an average of Solar Renewable Energy Credits. I&M customers potentially affected by this filing include those interested in voluntarily supporting the development of electricity generated by solar resources by subscribing to blocks of Solar Renewable Energy Certificates. A decision on the initial fixed block rate per kWh for I&M's Green Power Rider should be received from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission on or before September 10, 2015.

Archaeologists have uncovered human remains of four of the earliest leaders of the English colony that would become America, buried for more than 400 years near the altar of what was America's first Protestant church in Jamestown, Virginia.

The four burial sites were uncovered in the earthen floor of what was Jamestown's historic Anglican church from 1608, a team of scientists and historians announced Tuesday. The site is the same church where Pocahontas famously married Englishman John Rolfe, leading to peace between the Powhatan Indians and colonists at the first permanent English settlement in America.

Beyond the human remains, archaeologists also found artifacts buried with the colonial leaders - including a mysterious Catholic container for holy relics found in the Protestant church. The Jamestown Re-

discovery archaeology team revealed its discovery at the Smithsonian's National Museum of Natural History.

Archaeologists have been studying the site since 1994 when the original James Fort - long thought to be lost and submerged in the James River - was rediscovered. The church site was mostly untouched and had not been excavated for more than a century until it was found in 2010.

The team identified the remains of the Rev. Robert Hunt, Jamestown's first Anglican minister who was known as a peacemaker between rival leaders; Capt. Gabriel Archer, a nemesis of one-time colony leader John Smith; Sir Ferdinando Wainman, likely the first knight buried in America; and Capt. William West, who died in a fight with the Powhatan Indians.
