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GAS COSTS EDGE DOWN FOR CUSTOMERS OF INDIANA NATURAL GAS

Today, in Cause No. 37418-GCA 82 the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved the Gas Cost Adjustment for August, September and October 2004, requested by Indiana Natural Gas. Customers will pay slightly less than last quarter, and less than one year ago. The table below shows the impact on customers.
