IURC APPROVES NEW PROJECTS FOR RURAL MEMBERSHIP WATER CORP.

Today, in Cause No. 42258 U, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission today approved three water improvement projects requested by Rural membership Water Corporation in Clark County, Indiana.

The Commissioners agree that it is in the best interest of the ratepayers to allow the company to upgrade its infrastructure, and will allow the company to raise its rates to pay for the improvements. . Testimony presented to the Commission, shows that the area served by the company is expected to increase by as many as 1,000 new homes within the next two or three years, and improvements are necessary.

The table below shows the impact on customers.

The Rural Membership Water Corporation is a small, not-for-profit water utility serving in and around Henryville, Indiana. Petitioner presently serves approximately 1,880 customers. This is the first rate increase since in 1968.
