IURC APPROVES EXPANSION OF SERVICE AREA FOR THE CITY OF GREENFIELD MUNICIPALLY OWNED ELECTRIC UTILITY

Today, in Cause No. 42342, the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission approved the request of the City of Greenfield Municipal Electric Utility to expand its territory.

The City of Greenfield is the first to file its request under a new law passed by the Indiana General Assembly in 2002, which established an expedited procedure for utilities and state regulators to handle the transfer of utility service territory.

The newly annexed area includes 165 acres on the west side of Greenfield off of US 40. There are no customers in the area, which was previously within the service area assigned to Hancock County Rural Electric Membership Corporation, d/b/a Central Indiana Power.

Greenfield's Municipal Electric Utility serves 7,788 customers in and around the city of Greenfield.
